

### Troop History:

Troop 1 has been in existence for over 98 years making it one of the oldest Troops in the United States. Harry McClintock for whom Camp McClintock is named was involved in starting Troop 1. The first Eagle Scout in our Council came from Troop 1 - Keith Whiting. Prominent Bartians who have been members of Troop 1 include Phil Phillips son of Frank Phillips (founder of Phillips Petroleum Co), L.E. Phillips Jr. (Frank Phillips nephew) , Retired Senator Jerry Pierce, Gene Batchelder (ConocoPhillips CIO), and Don Doty (Ex-Judge).

### Scoutmaster History:

Wayde Hamilton is the 30<sup>th</sup> Scoutmaster in Troop 1. Wayde has taken several training courses offered by the B.S.A. such as Scout Adult Leadership Training (S.A.L.T.) and Woodbadge. Woodbadge Training is the highest training program offered by the B.S.A. He has conducted a Scout Adult Leadership Training Course serving as Scoutmaster of the course. He has served on staff of a Woodbadge Course. He was an Assistant Scoutmaster for Troop 1908 that attended the National Jamboree in 2001. He was the Scoutmaster for Troop 2130 that attended the National Jamboree in 2010 (celebrating 100 years of scouting). Wayde is a vigil member in the Order of Arrow. He was awarded the Scoutmaster Award of Merit by Cherokee Area Council in 2002. Wayde and his family were awarded the Osage Hill District Boy Scout Family of the Year Award in 1998. Wayde has worked at ConocoPhillips for over 21 years. He is married and has 2 sons. His oldest son earned his Eagle Award in Troop 1 in 2002. His youngest son is currently working on his Eagle Rank.
