

RULES AND GUIDELINES :

- Troop Meetings are held every Tuesday evening from 7:00 p.m. - 8:30 p.m. at First Christian Church (in the basement) at 5th and Osage. Each scout is expected to come to the meetings in their scout uniform and bring their scout handbook with them each week. Meetings will not be held when public schools are closed (Spring Break, Christmas Break, Holidays, etc.). Parents are always welcome at Scout Meetings.
- Meals on campouts typically run \$3.00 **each** meal. Everyone should bring money to pay for his food to the troop meeting prior to any campout. Refunds will not be made if a scout has to cancel plans to attend the camp out after the food is bought. Commission earned by scouts from selling popcorn is held in a special account to help the scout pay for meals, trips, etc.
- Parents are welcome to come along on campouts/trips. If you want to attend a campout, come to the weekly meeting prior to the campout so you can chip in for your part of the food and help with any planning that may need to be done.
- Boy Scouts and Leaders should wear their scout uniform to weekly troop meetings, campouts, council activities, etc. During the campout, it's ok to wear other clothes in order to protect your scout shirt. Everyone should be in a scout uniform while traveling to and from campouts.
- Scouts should live by the Scout Oath and Law at all times. If your son becomes a disciplinary problem during any scouting event, you will be called to come pick up your son. If the disciplinary problem continues, a parent may be required to accompany their son at all scouting events until the problem has been corrected.
- All Scouts and Adults will be expected to follow all BSA rules and policies.
